



Prof Robert Z. Lawrence – Guest Speaker at the Official Opening of TFCTN

About the Speaker

Robert Z. Lawrence is Albert L. Williams Professor of International Trade and Investment at Harvard University, a Senior Fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics, and a Research Associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research. He currently serves as Faculty Chair of The Practice of Trade Policy executive program at Harvard Kennedy School. He served as a member of the President's Council of Economic Advisers from 1998 to 2000. Lawrence has also been a Senior Fellow at the Brookings Institution. He has taught at Yale University, where he received his PhD in economics. His research focuses on trade policy. He is the author of *Crimes and Punishments? Retaliation under the WTO; Regionalism, Multilateralism and Deeper Integration; Single World, Divided Nations?*; and *Can America Compete?* He is coauthor of *Has Globalization Gone Far Enough? The Costs of Fragmentation in OECD Markets* (with Scott Bradford); *A Prism on Globalization; Globophobia: Confronting Fears About Open Trade; A Vision for the World Economy*; and *Saving Free Trade: A Pragmatic Approach*. Lawrence has served on the advisory boards of the Congressional Budget Office, the Overseas Development Council, and the Presidential Commission on United States-Pacific Trade and Investment Policy.
